**Levels:**

**Parent and Child Aquatics**-Parent and child participate in water adjustment, safety and basic skill activities

**Level 1**-Bridges infant toddler to Preschool levels. Introduction to swimming for non-swimmers with emphasis on basic motor skills, face in the water, blowing bubbles, holding breath, going under water and jumping in the water.

**Level 2**-For children who are comfortable, confident and already going underwater and holding their breath under the water. This class will focus on teaching unassisted swimming.

**Level 3**-For children who swim 5 feet unassisted with their face in the water. This class will focus on beginner's front crawl, arm recovery, independent breathing and an introduction to backstroke.

We also offer individual and group private lessons for Learn to Swim, Pre-competitive, Adult Beginner and Stroke clinics.

Upon successful completion of each Level students will receive an American Red Cross Learn To Swim Program certificate. There are no prerequisites for Level I. For Levels II-VI, students must have a certificate for the preceding level, or be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements for the previous Level.
